ICE & EAGLE FESTIVALS | 9-DAY

OUTLINE FOR THE TOUR

Ice Festival takes place each year during the first weekend of March on the frozen lake Khuvsgul, the Blue Pearl of Mongolia. The lake is set against a backdrop of mountains, deep pine forests and surrounded by grazing horses and yaks. It is located in the northernmost province at 1,645 meters above sea level, the second largest, deepest freshwater lake in Mongolia, second largest freshwater lake in Asia and also the largest tributary of Lake Baikal. In March and April freezes the lake completely over and ice forms to a depth of 1-2 meter creating an extraordinary winter playground. The nomadic reindeer herders, Tsaatan, from the north join local residents to celebrate the winter, with traditional games and races over two days. In temperatures of down to -30°C, contestants compete in sports such as ice-skating, ice-wrestling, dog-sledding and horse sleigh racing. Another highlight of the winter is to see the third largest Eagle hunting festival. It takes place in spring near to Ulaanbaatar with the aim of reviving the tradition of eagle hunting and passing it on to the next generations. Eagle hunters come from western Mongolia to participate at this festival and show their unique tradition.

DAY 1 / 26TH FEB ULAANBAATAR ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, meet our tour guide and transfer to a hotel. After a refreshing in the hotel, get ready to explore Ulaanbaatar City.

You will visit Gandan monastery, the largest Buddhist Monastery in Mongolia that houses well over 500 monks.

After lunch in a restaurant we will visit Chinggis Khaan Museum, the nine-story modern museum with 15 exhibition halls.

Have welcome dinner in western restaurant and transfer back to your hotel.

DAY 2 / 27TH FEB CHINGGIS KHAAN STATUE COMPLEX & TERELJ NATIONAL PARK 200KM

Today we will travel to the country side, our first visit will be the famous Chinggis Khaan Statue Complex for an impressive sight.

Afterwards travel to Terelj National Park. Have lunch in ger camp and visit the Turtle Rock and Arbayala Temple for its stunning view of the whole park in winter.

Return to the city and transfer to the train station and take overnight train to Erdenet.

DAY 3/ 28TH FEB NORTH MONGOLIA / ERDENET- KHUVSGUL LAKE 495 KM

Early morning arrival in the second largest city of Erdenet. Erdenet was built in 1975 for workers at the new copper mine.

Experience your breakfast in a local deli shop before we start the tour by 4x4 jeep heading to Khuvsgul lake through province center Murun.

You will have lunch on the way and arrival at the camp late afternoon, where you will stay for next 2 nights. Overnight at the camp.

DAY 4-5 / 01ST-02ND MAR NORTH MONGOLIA /KHUVSGUL LAKE- ICE FESTIVAL

You will enjoy the opening ceremony of the ice festival with cultural performances, parade of dog sleds, horse sleds and ice-skaters. You will see beautifully carved ice sculptures, many traditional and sport competition including ice shooting

competition, contest of ice sculpture, contest of traditionally dressed people in their winter clothes and a shamanic ritual.

Travelers can take part in some of fun competitions like sumo wrestling on the ice and ice target archery shooting. It is great time and place for trying dog sledding and horse sledding.

Glue wine in ICE bar keeps you warm and enjoy bon fire in the evening.

DAY 6 / 03RD MAR

NORTH MONGOLIA /ERDENET 495KM

After having breakfast depart to the center of Khuvsgul province. You will visit the local market and have lunch in a fine restaurant. Drive further to Ulaanbaatar and the overnight is in Erdenet city on the way. You will relax in the comfort hotel room.

DAY 7 / 04TH MAR

ULAANBAATAR 380 KM

Have an early start to Ulaanbaatar through winter forest and steppe. Have lunch on the way and arrive in city in the late afternoon. Transfer to the hotel and after some refreshing time take a shopping tour including world famous cashmere store and souvenir shop.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

DAY 8 / 05TH MAR

ULAANBAATAR 40 KM

Breakfast at the hotel and drive south of the city to see the Eagle Hunting Festival.

You will enjoy Various contests, such as selecting the best dressed, calling their eagles, testing its skills with a fake stuffed animal, Kokpar (tug of war over goatskin while on horseback) as well as a

contest to grab the silver coins laid on the ground while galloping on a horse, are taking place.

On top of the events, the display of traditional Kazakh handcrafts was also what caught the guests' attention.

Drive back to Ulaanbaatar and have farewell dinner. Overnight in the hotel.

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CAMEL & EAGLE FESTIVALS | 8-DAY

OUTLINE FOR THE TOUR

Imagining the Gobi-desert in the winter with golden sands covered by white snow might make you unbelievable. You can experience famous Mongolian Gobi in winter and become part of Mongolian nomads. Thousand Camel Festival has been organized for already 20 years, by local camel herding communities under the purpose of protecting two humped Bactrian camels and increase income and productivity of local nomads through tourism. This colorful event has started attracting many travelers including international and local visitors. It is worth to explore for culture lovers since this has already become one of the most famous winter festivals in the world.

Another highlight of the winter is to see the third largest Eagle hunting festival. It takes place in spring near to Ulaanbaatar with the aim of reviving the tradition of eagle hunting and passing it on to the next generations. Eagle hunters come from western Mongolia to participate at this festival and show their unique tradition.

DAY 1 / 03RD MAR ULAANBAATAR ARRIVAL

Early start after the breakfast at the hotel heading to South Gobi. Mongolian Gobi is not only famous for its beauty, camels, nomads, dinosaur findings but also it has been known as its winter scene.

You will have lunch in Middle Gobi and arrival in Bulgan in the late afternoon where the festival takes place. Overnight in a guest house.

DAY 4-5 / 06TH 07TH MAR SOUTH GOBI/ THOUSAND CAMEL FESTIVAL

Enjoy the festival for 2 full days. Nomads gather from far and near in their best traditional costume and ridden best camels to attend the festival.

The main events of the festival are: opening ceremony, parade of camel riders, camel polo, best looking couple on a beautiful camel and etc. It is not only the event of competition also Mongolian musicians and dancers show off folk performances. As an excursion drive to the world- famous Flaming Cliffs and Bayanzag, rich in Gobi saxaul trees. Overnight in guest house in Bulgan soum.

Visit the Turtle Rock and Arbayala Temple for its stunning view of the whole park. Visiting a nomadic family would introduce you to their lifestyle and the hospitality. Having a horseback ride with the herdsman is a must. Overnight in ger camp.

DAY 4

CENTRAL MONGOLIA / CHINGGIS KHAAN STATUE COMPLEX UB 80 KM

This day another adventure for dog sledding on completely frozen freshwater river Tuul. This will provide you a unique opportunity to mix adventure and sightseeing in beautiful scenery. Travel to Chinggis Khaan Statue Complex on dog sleds for 25 km for 3-4 hours.

Arrive at the famous Chinggis Khaan Statue Complex for an impressive sight. Explore the massive and shiny statue which is the largest equestrian and Chinggis Khaan in the world. Drive back to Ulaanbaatar and have dinner in the hotel. Overnight in the hotel.

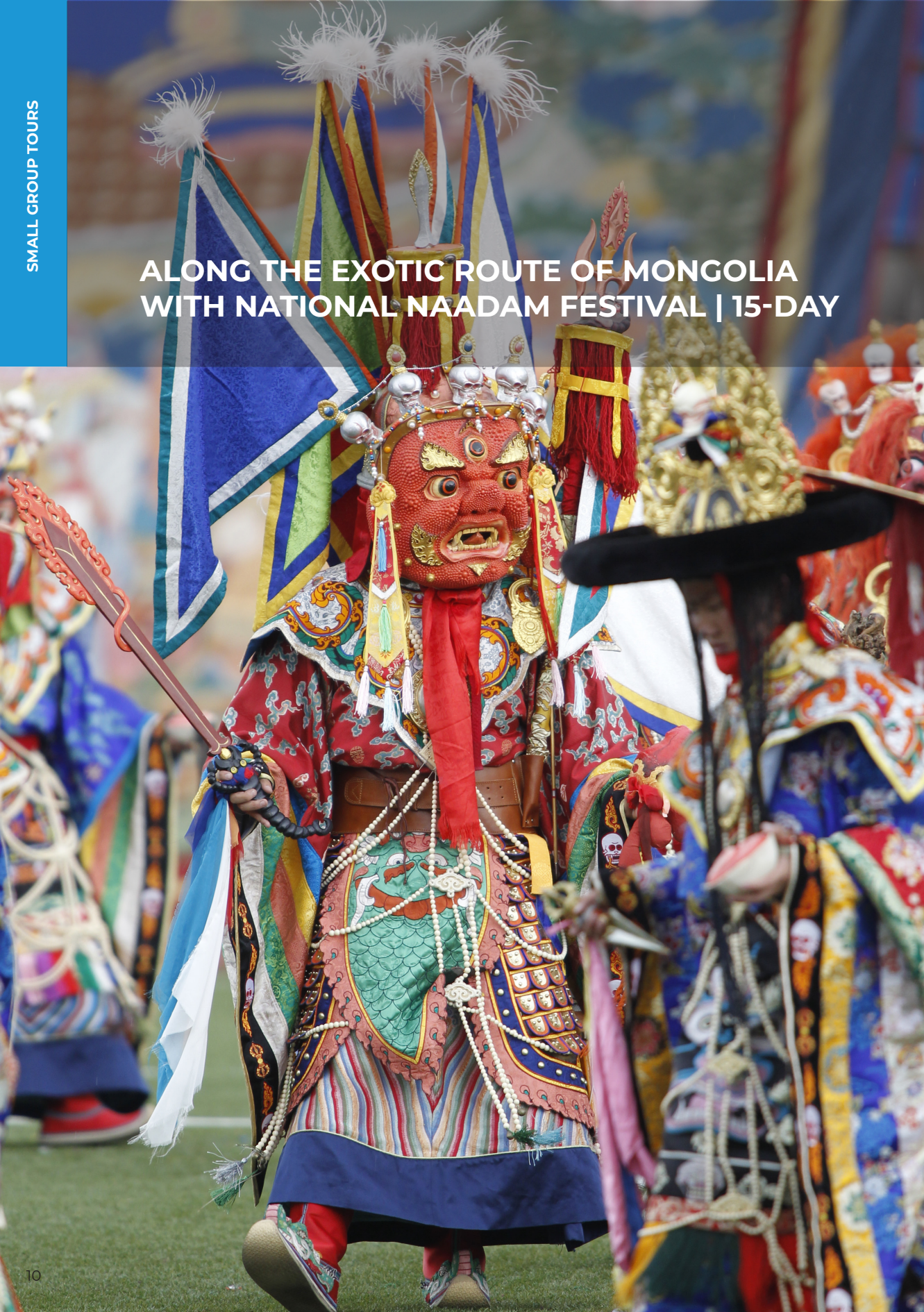

DAY 1 / 29TH JUN

ULAANBAATAR ARRIVAL

You will visit Gandan monastery, the largest Buddhist Monastery in Mongolia that houses well over 500 monks.

DAY 2 / 30TH JUN

MIDDLE GOBI / BAGA GAZRIIN CHULUU 245 KM

Drive to Middle Gobi where the mountains would disappear and the huge open steppe would start. Arrive at Baga Gazriin Chuluu, a unique rock formation and a lovely rock-strewn range full of canyons, caves and a solitary lake. You will stay at a ger, which is a traditional felt tent that has been used for housing by the nomads since ancient times. The ger would be your accommodation for the duration of your trip in the countryside. Far away from light pollution your chance to gaze at the millions of stars would also start from today. Overnight in ger camp.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

DAY 3 / 01ST JUL

MIDDLE GOBI / TSAGAAN SUVRAGA 230 KM

The direction for today is to the south. One of the travels highlighted of Middle Gobi is Tsagaan Suvraga where you will see a white Lime Stone cliff having 10 million years of history and its beauty. Have your own time and explore the area. Stay overnight in ger camp.

DAY 4 / 02ND JUL

SOUTH GOBI / YOLIIN AM 220 KM

Have an early start on heading to the Southern Gobi. The shimmering heat and isolated gers and herds of camels plus the images of lakes that is none other than a mirage are a typical sight you will see. Spend the day hiking and enjoying stunning photographic opportunities at the Yol Valley, part of the Three Beauties Mountain range of the Gobi National Park. Prepare for the evening's sunset, a magnificent moment to take away as a perfect memory of South Gobi. Stay overnight at ger camp.

DAY 5 / 03RD JUL

SOUTH GOBI / KHONGORYN ELS 200 KM

Today we will travel to Khongoryn Els. Upon arrival check in at ger camp.

After lunch visit a camel breeding family and get

introduced to the way of Mongolian nomads and their way of life.

Explore Mongolia's largest Sand Dune Khongoryn Els, which is also popularly known as the 'Singing Dunes'. Drive back to the ger camp and stay overnight.

DAY 6 / 04TH JUL **SOUTH GOBI/ BAYANZAG FLAMING CLIFFS 170 KM**

In the morning begin your journey to Bayanzag Flaming Cliffs for the magnificent landscapes and the place where the first ever fossilized dinosaur eggs were found. Stay overnight in ger camp.

DAY 7 / 05TH JUL **MIDDLE GOBI / ONGYN KHIID 185 KM**

Today we will travel to Ongyn Khiid, driving from central to northwest point of the Gobi. Stay overnight in ger camp.

DAY 8 / 06TH JUL **CENTRAL MONGOLIA / ORKHON VALLEY AND KHARAKORUM 270 KM**

Today we explore Mongolia's Ancient Capital City Karakorum located in the Orkhon Valley and The surrounding Orkhon Valley. Stay overnight in ger camp.

DAY 1 / 09TH JUL ULAANBAATAR

Upon arrival meet your guide and transfer to your hotel.

DAY 2 / 10TH JUL ULAANBAATAR

After breakfast taking the city tour including Gandan monastery, National history museum and enjoy Naadam festival`s eve by watching the National Costume festival in the Sukhbaatar Square. Have dinner at a fine restaurant. Overnight at hotel.

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are included.

DAY 3 / 11TH JUL ULAANBAATAR / NATIONAL NAADAM FESTIVAL

Naadam Festival officially starts today and everyone should brace themselves for a festive and busy day. Transfer to the National Stadium and get seated with locals and thousands of tourists from all over the world who had come to watch the festival under one roof. Naadam Ceremony opens with the Mongolian President`s speech and a performance by country's leading dancers, athletes, horse riders and musicians would take place. Escape the stadium for lunch and come back to the see the strong wrestlers and sharp archers. Walk around the stadium to see the ankle-bone shooting game and enjoy the local atmosphere with local Mongolians. Watch a special Mongolian folklore concert and have a festive Gala dinner in the evening. Back to the hotel and spend the overnight.

Breakfast, Lunch & Gala dinner are included.

DAY 4 / 12TH JUL ULAANBAATAR / NATIONAL NAADAM FESTIVAL -KHUSTAI NP 110 KM

Drive for an hour outside of Ulaanbaatar City for the national horse race. Walk to the horses` finishing line and get seated with boxed lunches. The horse jockeys for the event are all children between 5 to12 year old and many of them have been in the saddle since ages of 1 to 3. Watch and feel the emotion in the children and their horses when they complete the 20kilometer distance while competing with from over 300 other horse and their jockeys. Drive further to the Khustai National Park, which is famous for preservation of its Przewalski or wild horses that had been reintroduced back into the wild. The National Park is famous not only for its wild horses but other mammals, floras and faunas. Get introduced to the National Park and proceed deep inside the park to search for the prized wild horses Spend the night at a nearby ger camp.

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are included.

DAY 5 / 13TH JUL CENTRAL MONGOLIA/ UGII LAKE 230 KM

Start driving to Lake Ugii with free stops on the way for d photographing the charming landscape and wildlife. Arrive at Lake Ugii camping site. In the evening, hiking around the lake and enjoy watching the birds. Dinner and overnight in the camp.

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are included.

DAYS 6 / 14TH JUL CENTRAL MONGOLIA / TSENHER HOT SPA 110 KM

This day journey would take you to the Tsenher Hot Spa where you will enjoy the natural hot spa, you can also have a short hike in the surrounding forest during the day. Having the spa after dinner in the evening is another experience. Body massage and

The day is to explore Mongolia's Ancient Capital City Karakorum located in the Orkhon Valley. Chinggis Khaan's choice of Karakorum city as the capital of the empire in Central Mongolia was no coincidence. The surrounding Orkhon Valley was the center of action for various nomadic dynasties that preceded the Mongol Empire and holds enormous symbolic importance. Here you will explore the Erdenezuu monastery, museum of Karakorum, Phallic Rock and Turtle Rock. Stay overnight in ger camp.

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are included.

DAY 8 / 16TH JUL

MIDDLE GOBI / ONGYN KHIID 270 KM

Wake up early to proceed to Ongyn Khiid through driving from central to the south to Gobi. 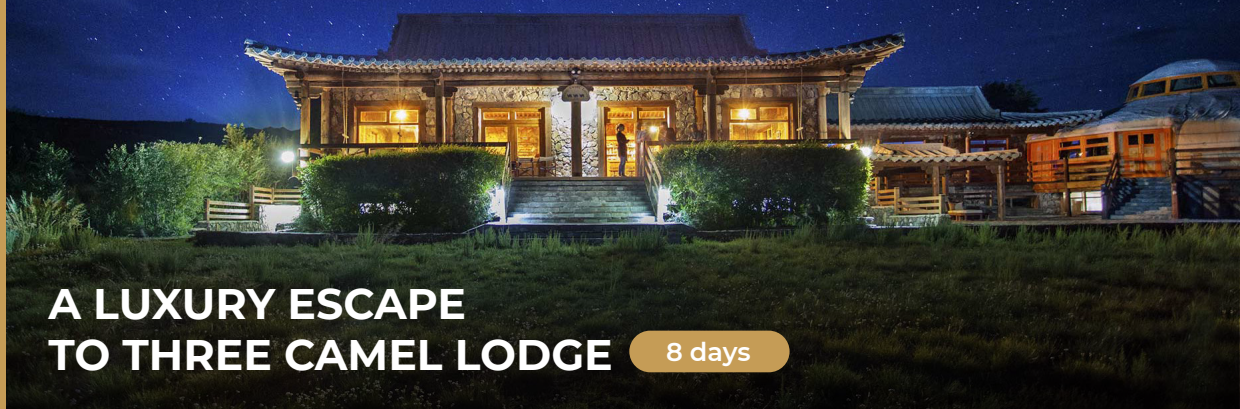

Visit Chinggis Khaan Museum, the nine-story modern museum with 15 exhibition halls. The museum has a total of 11,000 pieces of archeological items and antiques related to XIII century.

In the evening enjoy a colorful Mongolian Folklore concert including folkloric dancing & singing, contortion and Khoomii etc. Have welcome dinner in western restaurant and overnight in Shangri-La ***** hotel.

Lunch & Dinner are included.

DAY 2

SOUTH GOBI / YOL VALLEY 125 KM

In the morning fly over the vast steppe land to the Gobi (1.5 hours), Mongolia's southernmost province of consisting of a semi-arid desert. Contrary to the sterile sameness to the word "desert" suggests, the Gobi holds many fascinations including sites of some of the most important paleontological discoveries of this century. For the next three days, you will explore the stunning landscape of the Gobi, habitat for Bactrian camels, Argali wild sheep, goitered gazelle, golden eagles, saker falcons, jerboas - similar to kangaroo rats - and many endemic reptiles. The Gobi is also home to some of the Northern Hemisphere's rarest and most elusive mammals such as dhole, snow leopard and Gobi Bear.

Upon arrival, drive to Yol Valley National Park (2.5 hours), a mountain range cradled between the foothills of the Altai Mountains. An ancient river carved this surprisingly green valley. Now, its remnant streams create ice formations at the base of the valley that sometimes persist as late as July. A hike through the valley allows you to discover habitat for indigenous vulture-like lammergeyers, Altai snowcocks, ibex, yaks and Argali wild sheep. Enjoy visiting the local natural history museum for an overview of the flora and fauna of the area. Next, transfer to Three Camel Lodge located at Gobi Gurvan Saikhan National Park.

Overnight in Three Camel Lodge ger camp. Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are included.

DAY 3

SOUTH GOBI / KHAVTSGAIT PETROGLYPH 50 KM

Wake early to the sight of the sun rising over the vast Gobi landscape. Following breakfast, start driving to Khavtsgait to see the amazing artwork of our ancestors. Preserved at the top of the mountain are some of the precious petroglyphs of the Gobi, ancient and beautiful works of art that can be clearly seen as the sun hits the rocks from the right angle. After lunch at the Three Camel Lodge restaurant, Gobi Oasis, travel to visit a local cooperative making traditional handcrafts. In the late afternoon, begin driving to Tugrugiin Shiree (1.5 hours), a white escarpment where the famous "Fighting Dinosaurs" fossil of a Protoceratops and Velociraptor locked in combat was discovered in the 1970s. Return to the Three Camel Lodge to enjoy drinks on the lodge veranda or join the lodge chef to learn to cook Mongolian traditional dumplings.

Overnight in Three Camel Lodge ger camp. Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are included.



DAY 4

SOUTH GOBI / BAYANZAG FLAMING CLIFFS 60 KM

After a leisurely breakfast drive to the legendary Flaming Cliffs (1 hour), named for the red-orange sandstone that glows brilliantly at sunrise and sunset. It was here in 1923 that Dr. Roy Chapman Andrews and his exploration team from the American Museum of Natural History found the first nest of dinosaur eggs the world had ever seen. To the trained eye, the ancient formations of the Flaming Cliffs are rich with fossils, and paleontological expeditions continue to make significant discoveries at this site. You will enjoy the Gobi sunset at this magnificent site.

Overnight in Three Camel Lodge ger camp.

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are included.

DAY 5

SOUTH GOBI / MOLTSOG ELS 110 KM

After a leisurely breakfast drive to Moltsoq Els (1.5 hours), one of the few regions of the Gobi covered by sand dunes. Explore the area on foot. There will also be an opportunity to learn the basics of riding a camel and exploring the area on camelback as well. Overnight in Three Camel Lodge ger camp.

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner are included.

DAY 6

FLY BACK TO ULAANBAATAR 70 KM

Have an early or a packed breakfast. Transfer to Dalanzadgad town and fly back to Ulaanbaatar. Transfer to your hotel in Ulaanbaatar city and have your own day.

Overnight in Shangri-La ***** hotel.
