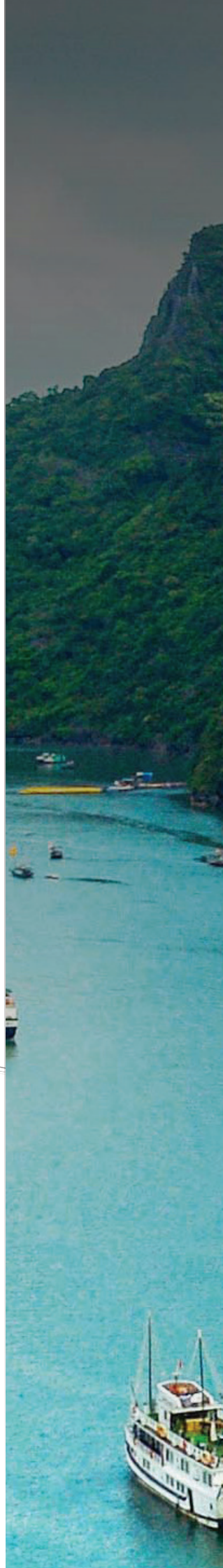

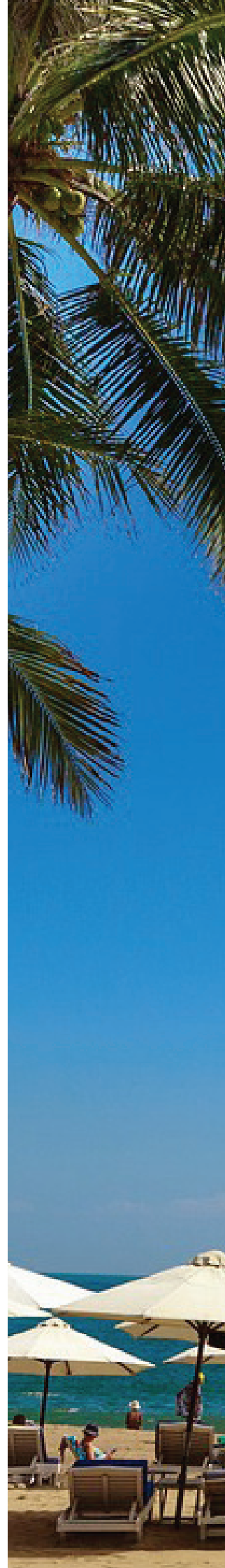

REASONS TO VISIT VIETNAM

COUNTRY, PEOPLE & CULTURE

Vietnam is a relatively safe country to visit and it has a very precious treasure: its people! Many tourists are pleasantly surprised by the warm reception that foreign travellers receive from Vietnamese locals as they are found to be extremely friendly and hospitable.

The Vietnamese culture is richly embedded in its people and their way of life. The discovery of this unique culture is an interesting and fascinating journey, making Vietnam an increasingly popular tourist destination.

From the rice-cultivating tropical lowlands, to the rich-soiled, coffee producing highlands, Vietnam offers a unique and varied travel experience.

Life in the Mekong Delta is deeply connected to water. The lowlands are continually sliced by rivers and streams filled with boats.

Da Lat is an unmissable city to visit, located in the central highlands of Southern Vietnam. Da Lat was originally founded by the French as a vacation town and is often given the name "City of Eternal Spring" because of the mist that often covers the peaks and valleys.

Moving up to central Vietnam you will discover seemingly endless, white sandy beaches and picturesque coastlines. The central coast is scattered with luxurious resorts and hotels and experiences perfect weather conditions all year round.

Ha Long Bay is a recognised UNESCO World Heritage Site that is best known for its emerald waters and its thousands of towering limestone islands which are topped by rainforests.

In the north-west of Vietnam, near the Chinese border, rice terraces can be found in the Muong Hoa valley between Sa Pa town and the Fansipan Mountain, on a backdrop of thick bamboo woodlands. Here you will find many ethnic minorities known as the local Hill Tribe People.

VIETNAM FOOD

Vietnam food is one of the world's most up and coming cuisines. Expect healthy and fragrant dishes flavoured with lemongrass, fish sauce, lime, tamarind and chili.

You will find the best food right on the streets of every town. Settle down on the little blue or red chairs and enjoy a spicy Pho or Banh My, or any other local dishes. Every dish contains a careful balance of flavours topped with fresh herbs and is sold at unbelievably affordable prices.



PLANNING YOUR HOLIDAY

Vietnam is typically warm and humid and the weather can vary significantly from one region to another. Average temperature is 12-32 degrees in the north, 20-30 degrees in central Vietnam and 25-30 degrees in the south.

TRAFFIC

Traffic in Vietnam can be extremely hectic. It does not matter if you as a pedestrian have a green light or if there is a crossing marked on the road, do not expect cars and bikes to stop to let you cross. Watch the locals first to see how they do it, then take off from the side walk, arm in arm. If there is more than one of you, walk slowly and steady in a straight direction and do not stop or steer off course. The traffic will automatically avoid you.

CURRENCY

The official currency in Vietnam is the Vietnamese "Dong". There is currently two versions of notes used: the Polymer note (500.000 VND, 200.000 VND, 100.000 VND, 50.000 VND, 20.000 VND and 10.000 VND) and Cotton note 5000 VND 200 VND.

HEALTH

You are advised to make an appointment with your doctor or travel clinic for a basic check-up at least six to eight weeks before you depart and find out if any vaccinations or health checks are required for your destination. Remember that some vaccines require a long period to take effect and more than one dose may be required.

You should make sure that your travel insurance covers all medical expenses for injuries or illness, as well as theft of valuables, damage to baggage and cancellations or interruptions to flight plans. Medical costs overseas can be in the tens of thousands of dollars and many people have been burdened financially in paying these costs when things go wrong. Recommended Medical Checklist: insect repellents, diarrhoea medication, paracetamol, sunscreen, antiseptic and antibacterial cream.

LANGUAGE

Vietnamese is the official language, although English is widely understood in most major tourist areas and amongst the younger generations. Here are some Vietnamese phrases to assist you on your holiday.

WHY CHOOSE VIETNAM



Most people who travel to Vietnam are attracted by the country's wonderful natural beauty. From the green rice fields in the north to the fascinating bustle of the Mekong Delta in the south. Vietnam however is also a country with a long history and ancient traditions. There are a total of 8 World Heritage Sites recognized by UNESCO that are a must-see for visitors.

IMPERIAL CITADEL OF THANG LONG HANOI

The central sector of the Imperial Citadel of Thang Long-Hanoi is the archaeological site of the old capital of Vietnam, which originated in 1010. This makes it one of the oldest centres of power in the world that has been in use without interruption.

CITADEL OF THE HO DYNASTY

The Citadel of Ho Dynasty are the remains of a late 14th century castle constructed from stone blocks. It was constructed by the Hồ Dynasty from 1397 and is a symbol of neo-Confucianism.

TRANG AN LANDSCAPE COMPLEX

The Trang An landscape complex is a visually spectacular mountainous karst area with numerous caves that have provided shelter to humans for 32,000 years.

HUE COMPLEX OF MONUMENTS

Huế was the Imperial Capital of Vietnam between 1802 and 1945. The Capital City is a complex enclosed within defensive walls. It holds residences, palaces and gates, with the Forbidden Purple City at its heart.

HALONG BAY

The Bay holds over 1,600 islands and islets. There are caves and grottoes, with stalactites and stalagmites. Its limestone pillars are a unique natural feature of great scenic beauty and ecological interest.

MY SON SANCTUARY

My Son Sanctuary was the religious centre for the capital of the Champa Kingdom. The majority of it was built in the 10th century and lies in a valley surrounded by mountains.

HO AN ANCIENT TOWN

Hoi An is a traditional trading port in South-East Asia. It is the result of a fusion of cultures over time, from the 15th - 19th century. Its architecture is of traditional Vietnamese design, with Chinese and Japanese influences.

PHONG NHA - KE BANG

The site consists of two parts: Phong Nha Nature Reserve and Ke Bang forest. The area is noted for its Phong Nha and Vom cave systems. They are composed of 300 caves and grottos with a total length of about 126 km, of which only partly have been surveyed. The cave system has one of the world's longest underground rivers.

TOP 10 PLACES TO VISIT IN VIETNAM

MEKONG DELTA

Known as the 'rice bowl' of Vietnam, the Mekong Delta is a landscape carpeted in a dizzying variety of greens and slashed with mighty waterways. It's a water world where boats, houses, restaurants and even markets float upon the innumerable rivers, canals and streams that flow through the region like arteries. At times you can quite simply lose sight of land.

HO CHI MINH CITY

Ho Chi Minh city, formerly named Saigon, is the largest city in Vietnam. Discover the country's history by visiting the War Remnants Museum and Reunification Palace. Admire the French colonial architecture at the Federal Post Office, Opera House and Notre Dame Cathedral. From here you can explore the long maze of tunnels (Cu Chi) made by the Vietnamese people during the war.

NHA TRANG

Nha Trang is a charming seaside city which is renowned for its powder white sand and limpid green sea. Thanks to the tropical climate, Nha Trang has become one of the top destinations in Vietnam. Along with its natural beauty this coastal city's rich culture lures in tourists. Activities such as strolling through the streets lined with coconut palms, lying on white-sandy beaches bathing in the glorious sunshine, embarking on a luxury cruise or tasting the tempting seafood on the island province, are all bound make your Nha Trang vacation unforgettable. Nha Trang is also a popular destination for honeymooners.

DA NANG

Danang is nestled between three Cultural World Heritage Sites: Hue Citadel, Hoi An ancient town and the Sanctuary of My Son. Along with its beautiful landscapes this makes Da Nang a must-visit destination in Central Vietnam. Not only are tourists impressed by the natural beauty, but also by its hospitable and welcoming locals. Da Nang is an enthralling city, displaying a combination of tradition and modernism, creating a unique charm which appeals to travellers. You can go on an exciting journey exploring the historical relics, enjoy the pristine beaches and emerge yourself in the vibrant life of the city, all of which will make your trip to Da Nang an unforgettable experience. Da Nang is also another popular destination for honeymooners.

PHU QUOC ISLAND

One of the newest tourist destinations in Vietnam, this tropical island is boasting with natural beauty, luxury resorts and plenty of activities for the whole family to enjoy. Known for its white-sandy beaches and resorts, most of which are along the palm-lined southwest coast. More than half of the island's landmass is part of a national park featuring dense jungle and mountains which are popular for motorbiking, hiking and wildlife viewing.

HUE

Palaces and pagodas, tombs and temples, culture and cuisine history and heartbreak – there is no shortage of poetic pairings to describe Hue. Like many countries in Asia, Vietnam was formally ruled by dynasties of families; by feudal lords and ladies; by emperors with harems and grand palaces. Hue is where the Imperial Forbidden City is located. Although the Imperial City today is only a shadow of what it once was, it is still well worth a visit to discover the royal splendours thanks to recent restoration efforts.

SAPA

Established as a hill station by the French in 1922, the north west market town of Sapa is colourful and charming. The town is orientated around the most spectacular views that emerge on clear days. It overlooks a plunging valley of cascading rice terraces, with mountains towering above on all sides. Views of this epic scenery are often subdued by a thick mist rolling across the peaks, but even if it is cloudy, Sapa is still a fascinating destination especially when the local Hill-tribe people fill the town with colours during the weekend markets.

HANOI

A fascinating mix of old and new Vietnam with Chinese and French influences makes Hanoi one of the most beguiling cities in South East Asia. Hanoi is changing quickly but maintains a strong sense of identity. The city is full of things to explore, from the architecture of the Old Quarter to Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum and the Temple of Literature. There are many activities to do in Hanoi such as visiting the local markets, participating in tai chi with the locals and learning the secrets to Vietnamese cuisine in a cooking class. The city of Hanoi is also very affordable with most hotels and restaurants offering exceptional value.

HALONG BAY

Halong Bay is known for its emerald waters and thousands of towering limestone islands topped by rainforests. Junk boat tours and sea kayaking expeditions take visitors past islands named for their shapes, including Stone Dog and Teapot islands. The region draws scuba divers, rock climbers and hikers, the latter favouring the mountainous Cát Bà National Park.

CENTRAL VIETNAM HIGHLANDS

Vietnam's Central Highlands boasts ethnic diversity and beautiful natural features such as waterfalls and pine forests and spectacular sceneries and coffee plantations. Today foreigners can explore the main centres of this region with ease but there are some areas that will require you to hire a guide when trying to explore further.

Apart from trekking in the mountainous north, visitors can now also go rock-climbing, canyoning, sea kayaking, kitesurfing, zip lining, elephant riding, mountain biking and motor biking among other activities, making it the emerging adventure capital of Vietnam.

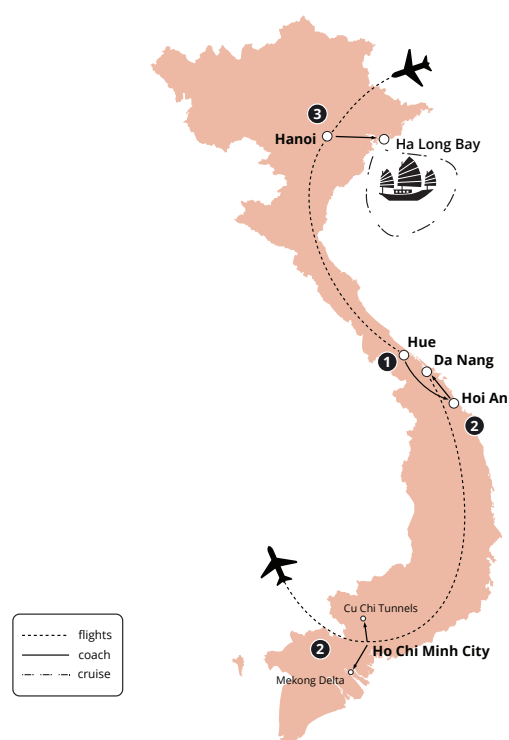

Day 1: Hanoi Arrival

On arrival at Noi Bai International Airport, our Tweet World Travel tour guide will welcome and transfer you to your hotel, enjoy the rest of the day to explore at your leisure before a Welcome Dinner at one of the finest restaurants in Hanoi.

Day 2: Hanoi City Tour

Visit Ba Dinh Square, Ho Chi Minh complex followed by the Temple of Literature. In the afternoon explore the Museum of Ethnology, the old quarter of Hanoi by cyclo (paddle rickshaw). In the evening, enjoy a traditional water puppet show at Thang Long Water Puppet Theatre.

Day 3: Hanoi - Halong Bay Day Trip

We leave Hanoi to Halong Bay on a 4-hour boat journey to pass Dog Islet, Cock Fighting Islet, Turtle Islet and Dau Go and Thien Cung caves.

Day 4: Hanoi - Flight to Hue - Hue City Tour

In the afternoon, we will visit the Imperial City, the Forbidden Purple City and the Dong Ba market.

Day 5: Hue - Hoi An

After breakfast set off for a dragon boat to cruise along the perfume river and visit Thien Mu pagoda and Emperor Tu Duc Tomb. Travel through the high pass of Hai Van with its spectacular views of the Pacific Ocean en route to Hoi An. On the way we will also visit Cham museum, My Khe beach and the Marble Mountain.

Day 6: Hoi An

Take a leisure walking tour in Hoi An and soak up its rich wealth of heritage. Visit the Japanese Merchant Houses, the famed Japanese bridge, Chinese temples, ancient houses and pagodas.

Day 7: Hoi An - Flight from Danang -

Ho Chi Minh City - Cu Chi Tunnels

Upon arrival, we will explore the infamous Cu Chi Tunnel, an immense network of underground tunnels used by the Vietcong as a military base during the Vietnam War. There are various mantraps on display and the remains of an American tank as well as numerous bomb craters made by B52 bombers.

Day 8: Mekong Delta Day Tour

At 08:00am, we transfer to Cai Be for our visit to colourful floating market cruising among local barges full of fruits and vegetables. Then, an optional stop can be made at local workshops where we can see how rice paste, coconut candy and pop-rice, popcorn is made, enjoy fruits when listening to the traditional music. It will be so amazing to bike on village paths to see the local farms, houses, real life and the ancestral ways to pick up fruits in Mekong Delta... The cruise will end at Vinh Long city where we take our own vehicle back to Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 9: Ho Chi Minh City Departure

Free time for leisure before we transfer to the airport.

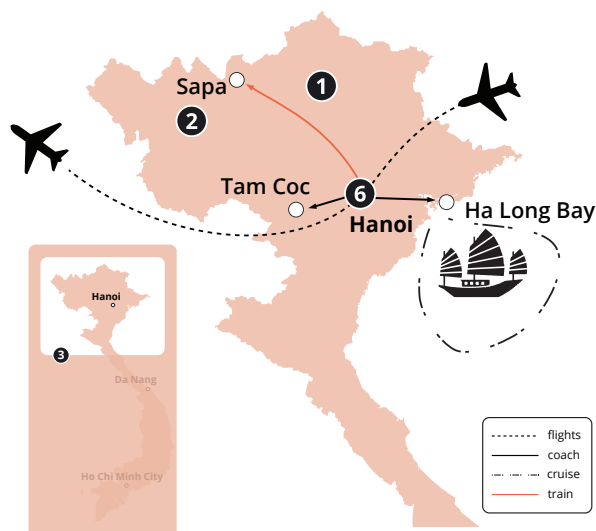

Day 1: Hanoi Arrival

On your arrival in Noi Bai International Airport, you will be welcomed by our tour guide and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2: Hanoi City Tour

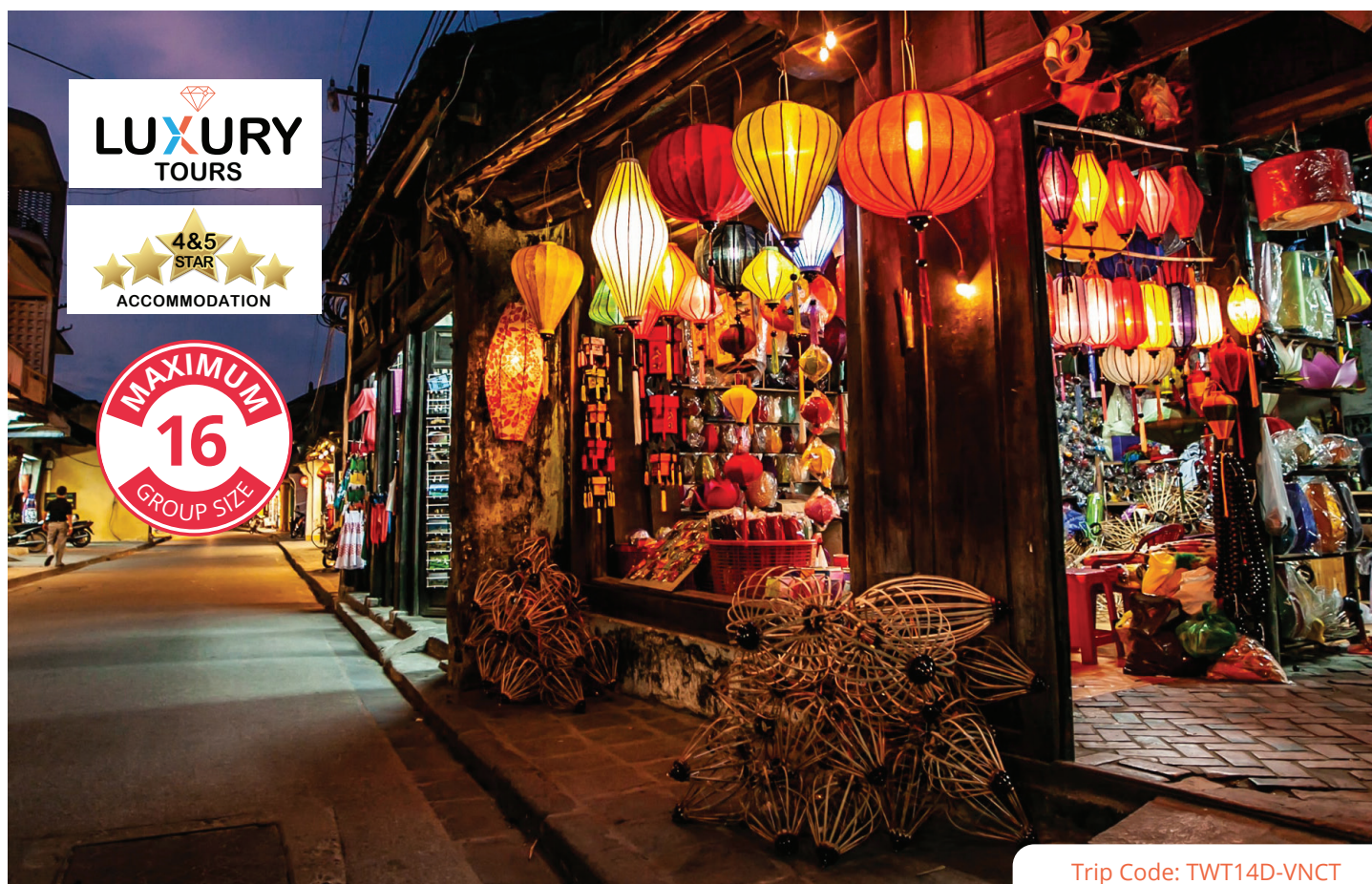

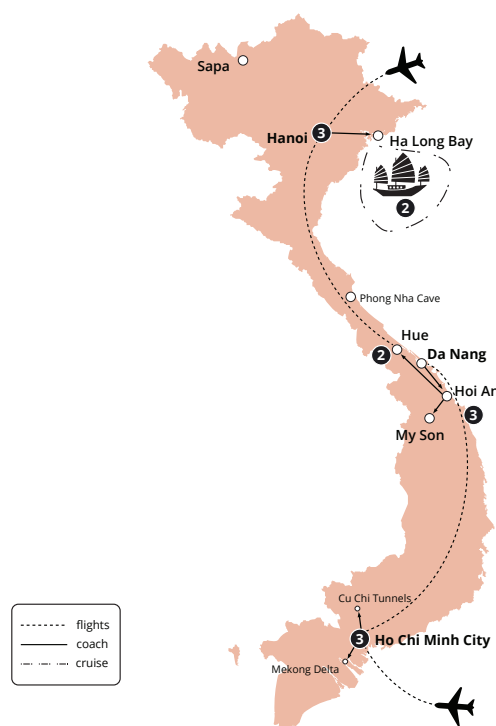

Day 1: Ho Chi Minh City Arrival

Day 1: Ho Chi Minh City Arrival

Arrival at Tan Son Nhat International Airport, you will be welcomed and transferred to your hotel.

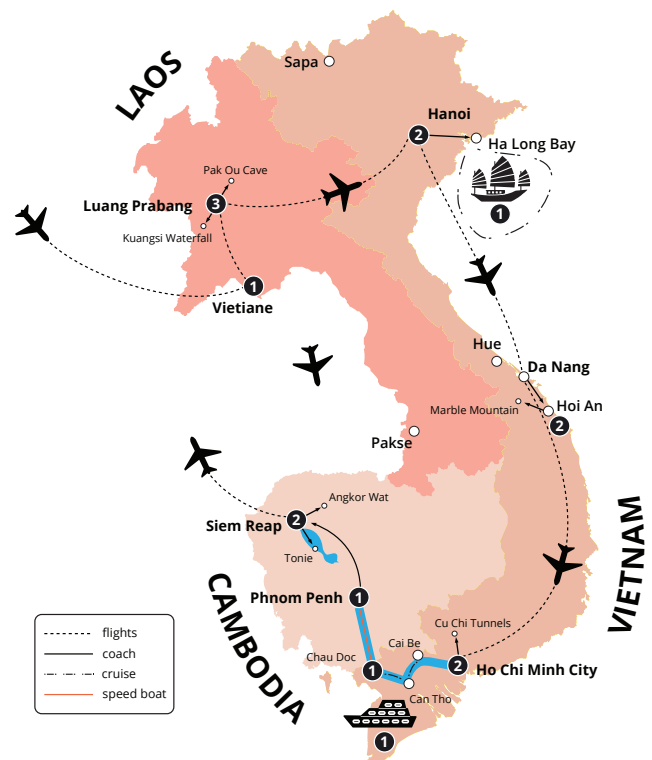

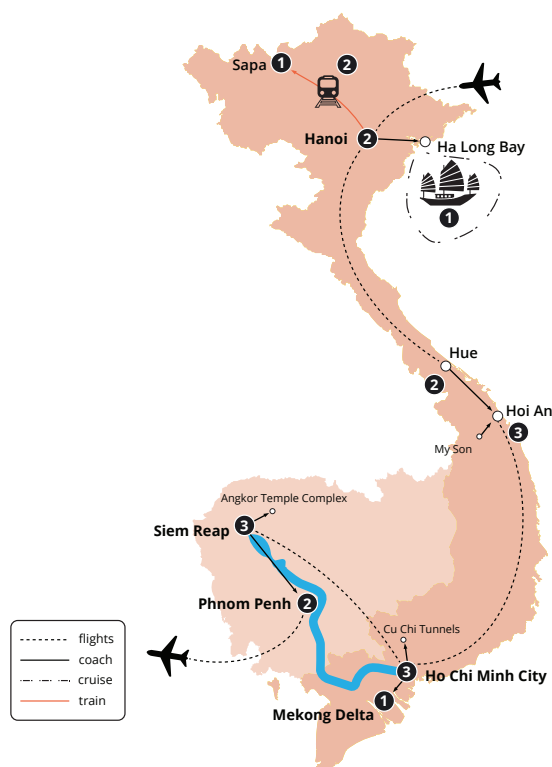

Day 1: Ho Chi Minh City Arrival

On arrival at Tan Son Nhat airport, we will be greeted and driven to our hotel in the city centre. After check-in, we will be free to wander around the hustle and bustle city and spend the night in Ho Chi Minh City. In the evening, enjoy your Welcome Dinner

Day 4: Mekong Delta – Hoi An

After breakfast at homestay, we say goodbye to the host and take the boat back to the mainland. Our bus is waiting and we continue to Can Tho to take the morning flight to Danang. Day 12: Sapa - Hanoi

We will enjoy a breakfast with our hosts before bidding them goodbye. Today will include a visit to the Giang Ta Chai village of the Red Dao minority people, we will also trek through a bamboo forest and pass by a majestic waterfall. Arriving in Sapa town and have lunch, we then have a short free time before getting on our Express Bus for the transfer back to Hanoi.

Day 13: Hanoi – Halong Bay

Today we set off to the 'Jewel in the Crown of Vietnam' – Halong Bay. Arriving before lunch we will board our boat and then set sail, cruising amongst thousands of extraordinary limestone Karst formations. We will then savor a delectable lunch while we sail among the limestone islands. In the mid-afternoon, we will kayak among the hidden areas of the bay, around the Bo Nau Cave area before going back to our cruise and continue cruising to Soi Sim Island. III. MODIFICATION OF THESE TERMS OF USE

Tweet Tour Operator reserves the right to change the terms, conditions, and notices under which the services of Tweet Tour Operator are offered, including but not limited to the charges associated with the use of the Tweet Tour Operator's service, without notice.

IV. BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. BOOKING

- You warrant that (i) you are 18 years of age or older, (ii) all information supplied by you during your course of using the Services is true, accurate, current and complete
- By asking us to confirm your booking with an international travel booking, we will assume that all travellers on the booking have a valid passport. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are in possession of the necessary documentation to comply with the laws and regulations of the countries to be visited.
- Passenger names must be provided exactly as per passport at the time of booking. Any spelling corrections made after a payment is paid must be sent in writing and will incur additional fees, including any ticket/voucher reissue fees and any Suppliers' re-issue fees.
By sending a payment or /paying for your booking, you acknowledge that the terms and conditions are fully understood, and agree to be bound by the terms, conditions and responsibilities set forth.
- Tweet World Travel reserves the right to correct any errors in rates quoted/invoice or calculated, or any omissions made at any time during your booking. Even once payment has been paid in full but an error in price has been found, Tweet World Travel reserves the right to correct any error.
- Tweet World Travel reserves the right to modify the price in case of exchange rate fluctuation while we provide a quote or make a booking for you. We continue to modify exchange rate even after your booking is made. The price is only guaranteed only when a booking is confirmed, and a full payment is already paid.
- Tweet World Travel reserves the right to substitute hotels, vessels and other forms of accommodation with properties or vessels of a comparable or higher standard.
- Tweet World Travel provides live availability of the Service, and the price is updated daily according to the exchange rate.
- Tweet World Travel is not a principal supplier of any Service, and when you make a booking via Booking Portal, your booking is a

direct contract between you and the applicable Supplier.

- By asking us to confirm your booking and paying deposit or full payment, you agree to be bound by the applicable Supplier's terms and conditions and any other rules or policies related to the Service. 5. CANCELLATION & CHANGE FEES

5.1 CHANGE FEES

- If you change any aspect of your booking, we will do our best to accommodate your request, but it may not always be possible. Request for change and amendments to your Booking, including name change or date change requests etc., should be made as below:
 - o These requests can be made in person in-store or via your online account, or via email to contact@tweetworldtravel.com.au. We do not accept any request made verbally or via phone.

Change Fee:

- o **Name Changes to Domestic/Trans-Tasman bookings** will incur a fee of \$69 per person in addition to travel service provider fees.
- o **Name Changes to International bookings** will incur a fee of \$99 per booking in addition to travel service provider fees.
- o Any date change for tour & cruise is considered as a cancellation and will be subject to cancellation charges. Subject to the availability and agreement with the Supplier, Tweet World Travel does not guarantee the success of any Change Request. A Supplier may charge a fee to accommodate a Change Request, and you will be required

to pay such fee. To the extent the Supplier is unwilling or unable to accept such Change Request, then your right to a refund (if any) shall be governed by the cancellation terms of your Booking.

5.2 CANCELLATION FEES

In all circumstances, you must check the cancellation policy contained in the invoice or your confirmation document at the time of your Booking, which is the policy that will apply to and govern the terms of your cancellation and any refunds.

Additional charges per booking cancellation

- o Administration fees: \$50 per person
- o Additional \$150 per person charges for themed-weekend and Christmas-market cruises are required.

- If a booking is cancelled or varied prior to departure due to unforeseeable circumstances such as, but not restricted to, severe weather conditions or force majeure, Tweet World Travel will either change your travel arrangements as reasonably practicable to ensure your safety and invoice you for any additional costs. Tweet World Travel will offer credits to any unused part of your holiday package for future travel up to 24 months.
- During your trip, in the event of strike, bad weather, or force majeure conditions endangering the operation of the vessel safely or extraordinary circumstances, Tweet World Travel may at all times and without notice, advance or delay a departure or a stopover or, if need be, change ports of call, and may not be held responsible in the event of cancellation, earlier or later departure or arrival, modification or substitution. Tweet World Travel will offer credits to any unused part of your holiday package for future travel up to 24 months. Tweet World Travel will not be liable to any additional associated costs incurred to the travellers whatsoever.
- Force majeure events are beyond our control, including but not limited to war, civil disobedience, terrorism, insurrection, accident, explosion, sickness, epidemic, pandemic, fire, floods, severe weather, acts of God, acts of Government, alteration or cancellation of scheduled air services, accidents to or failure of machinery or equipment or industrial action.

5.2.3 CANCELLATION BY THIRD-PARTY SUPPLIER

Tweet World Travel is not the principal supplier of the Service. One or multiple Third-party supplier(s) ("Supplier") are the principal supplier(s) of the "Service" provided to you.

If the Supplier change its schedules, or cancels their service for reasons beyond our control, we will use our reasonable endeavours to notify you.

If any such changes result in your Service costing more or otherwise being materially different, then you may cancel the Service. This may result in a monetary refund to you or travel credits to use in the future. The refund/credits may subject to cancellation and admin fees charged by us. Please check with your travel agents/ our consultant before cancelling or amending a Service in these circumstances.

6. SAFETY NET PROTECTION

Safety Net Protection is not included in our tour/cruise packages. If you wish to purchase Safety Net Protection, an additional fee of \$115 per person will occur. This is only valid for one-time use (claim).

- Safety Net Protection enables passengers to amend their Tweet Tours and/or Tweet World Cruises more than 30 days prior to departure, to another tour/cruise on the same destination departing in the same year (once only) without incurring cancellation charges or penalties from Tweet World Travel. The new tour must be at the same cost or higher, but cannot be at a lower cost than the initial tour booked. If the passengers choose the higher cost option, then the additional difference amount must be paid. However, no modifications shall be accepted less than 30 days prior to departure.

- Safety Net Protection is payable immediately at the time of making deposit payment. Once purchased, Safety Net Protection is not refundable.
- Safety Net Protection does not apply for airfares, or third-party fees and charges.
- Safety Net Protection allows for amendment ONLY, not cancellation.
- Safety Net Protection is not transferrable. It only applies to the booking's original passenger only.

V. LIABILITIES

- Tweet World Travel has no control over, or liability for, the Services provided by third-party Supplier(s). We disclaim and will be exempt from liability for anything to do with the supply of third parties' Services.
- By making a booking, you agree to accept all risks associated with the Supplier. You agree to unconditionally release Tweet World Travel from all liability, including without limitation in contract and in tort, for any cause or action, including any injury, damage, loss, cost, delay, additional expense or inconvenience caused directly or indirectly as a result of the inherent risks associated with the service made by the Suppliers, or any force majeure events or other events which are beyond our control, including but not limited to war, civil disobedience, terrorism, insurrection, accident, explosion, sickness, epidemic, pandemic, fire, floods, severe weather, acts of God, acts of Government, alteration or cancellation of scheduled air services, accidents to or failure of machinery or equipment or industrial action.
- Tweet World Travel will not be liable for any injury, damage, loss, cost, delay, additional expense or inconvenience associated with unforeseeable circumstances such as force majeure, adverse weather, flight rescheduling and faults with transportation or road conditions may also have an effect on the operation of the Service. We strongly urge you to undertake a high level of personal responsibility in order to ensure that possessions, equipment and personal documents are closely monitored and protected at all times. We also strongly advise you to purchase appropriate travel insurance to protect you from financial loss and personal injuries in the event of an emergency.

You agree to release Tweet World Travel and its Supplier(s) from any liability associated with any variation or cancellation.
- The Supplier(s) are not our consultants or employees and are not under our direct control. We therefore do not warrant the performance of any Supplier. We do not accept, and you release us from, all liability for any injury, loss, damage, costs or expenses, including without limitation any property damage or personal injury, that you may suffer which arises out of any act or omission of a Supplier who provides arrangements for the Service(s) that you book. Any claim that you may have in relation to a Supplier should be raised directly with that Supplier.
- You are responsible for any injury, loss, damage, costs or expenses arising through your own fault. You agree to indemnify us against all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, expenses and costs (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis and whether incurred

by or awarded against us) as a result of, or arising in relation to, whether directly or indirectly, your participation in the Service or any act or omission by you in relation to the Service.

- To the extent permitted by law, we do not accept any liability in contract, or otherwise for any injury, damage, loss (including consequential loss), delay, additional expenses or inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by the acts, omissions or default, whether negligent or otherwise, of the Supplier(s) over which we have no direct control. VI. AGENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- It is your responsibility to advise us, your travel agent or the Supplier of your departure and arrival time, or any changes or delays you might encounter. If you do not notify us, your travel agent or the Supplier in a timely manner and you arrive on a delayed flight and miss your allocated pick up (if the Service provide Airport Transfer), you will need to make alternative arrangements at your own expense.
- If your Service include Airport Transfer, your arranged Airport Transfer service will pick you up as scheduled and may attempt to wait for your scheduled arrival up to 30 minutes. If your delay is longer than this waiting period, you will have to make alternative arrangements at your own expense.

- It is your responsibility to notify us of any dietary requests/requirements. We will pass on this information to the Supplier(s) these requests/requirements, however, cannot guarantee that they can always be accommodated.
- All parties understand that any medical or dietary information provided to us does NOT, under any circumstances, make Tweet World Travel and its Suppliers liable if a particular condition exacerbates while using the Service, which might affect their ability to participate in any portion of the Service.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that all invoice, itinerary details and documentation issued by Tweet World Travel, your travel agent or the Supplier(s) are received and correct, and that the customer is aware of amendment and cancellation conditions and other clauses in these Booking Terms & Conditions. You acknowledge that you fully understand and agree to Tweet World Travel's Terms & Conditions at the time of booking.
- After a booking is made, if the Supplier(s) require information of your legal documents, you will need to provide us or the Supplier this information via your online account, Passenger Online Booking Form or via email to us or your travel agents. If these required documents are not received within 3 working days, the respective booking will be void.
- Travel voucher may be issued instantly depending on the Service you book, or will be issued and sent to you or your travel agents from 7 -15 days prior to departure. Make sure all travellers have obtained their travel voucher before travelling. The Supplier may require you to present the travel voucher to participate in the Service.
- If the traveller(s) travels without our provided travel voucher, they might be denied embarking/joining the Service. It is your responsibility to contact to obtain all necessary travel documents.

- Please make sure you read and understand the travel vouchers, and that the travel voucher matches your booking.  - All persons are fit and physically able to partake unaided in their chosen Service etc. as outlined in the itinerary.
 - All parties acknowledge the physical demands and hazards involved in the Service they will be undertaking and have chosen to participate at their own risk.
 - All parties understand that any medical or dietary information provided to us DOES NOT, under any circumstances, make Tweet Tour Operator liable if a particular condition exacerbates while on the trip which might affect their ability to participate in any portion of the trip

IX. TRAVEL INSURANCE

- The Service you book DOES NOT include Travel Insurance
- For your protection, we strongly recommend that you purchase

comprehensive travel insurance for your travel arrangements (without limitation) that include coverage for medical expenses, loss of luggage, cruise, land content and airfare charges that may occur.

X. PUBLICITY

- We may disclose your personal information to our related companies, carriers, travel service providers, organisations which provide services to you.
